## Forest path with flowers and sunbeams - acrylic painting course

## Materials list

Please note: you can use any brand of acrylic... and mix different brands together! As long as your primary colours are relatively "pure" (don't have white mixed in) you should experience similar colour results. However, feel free to use your own personal favourite blue, red and yellow paints to get the colour results that you like!


## Acrylic paint (you don't need to use these brands)

- Phthalo Blue (green shade)
- Cadmium Yellow medium
- Cadmium Red medium
- Quinacridone Magenta
- White



## Tools:

- Size 50 flat mottler ( 5 cm or $2^{\prime \prime}$ flat brush)
- Size 20 flat mottler ( 2 cm or $3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ flat brush)
- Size 10 flat brush ( 1 cm or $1 / 3^{\prime \prime}$ flat brush)
- Small diamond-shaped palette knife (approx. 4 cm or $1.5^{\prime \prime}$ long)
- Medium diamond-shaped palette knife (approx. 7 cm or $23 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ long)


## Canvas:

I used a $40 \times 50 \mathrm{~cm}\left(16 \times 20^{\prime \prime}\right)$ stretched canvas (already on a wooden frame) with a 38 mm ( $1.5^{\prime \prime}$ ) side profile.

I taped the sides with a general purpose Scotch masking tape to stop paint getting on the sides. If you do this, leave a small gap of canvas around the top edge so your painting "spills over" a tiny bit.
